- Personal identity is formed through an interdependence of biological sex and culturalsocial norms.


What does gender theory say?


 That gender is purely determined by society or the individual, independent of biological sex.

What does gender ideology seek?


- Freedom from biological sex.

Main premises of "life of Brian"


- "It's every man's right to have babies if he wants them. Don't you oppress me."

Shift in mindset.

Comparison Criteria	Life of Brian	Zootopia
The body	Reality which "speaks". Offers clues/norms for correct behavior.	Does not "speak" Offers no norms for correct behavior.
Rights	Against oppression. But physical reality is not oppression.	Against oppression. Physical reality can sometimes be oppressive if it gets in the way of your will/desire.
Achieving Happiness	Harmonising desires with the language of your body.	Manipulating your body to harmonise with your desires.

Inevitable conclusion: Gender is binary (malefemale), not fluid.



LGBTQ theory has many contradictory claims



- a. Homosexual theory sexual attraction is in-born and *unchangeable*
- b. Queer theory Gender is *fluid*, exists on a *spectrum* and is not only male-female
- c. Transgender theory there are **2 genders** (male/female), **no spectrum**



Pope Francis on Gender theory

 It is a source of concern that some ideologies of this sort, which seek to respond to what are at times understandable aspirations, manage to assert themselves as absolute and unquestionable, even dictating how children should be raised. It needs to be emphasized that "biological sex and the socio-cultural role of sex (gender) can be distinguished but not separated".



Pope Francis on Gender theory

 It is one thing to be understanding of human weakness and the complexities of life, and another to accept ideologies that attempt to sunder what are inseparable aspects of reality. Let us not fall into the sin of trying to replace the Creator.

We are creatures, and not omnipotent. Creation is prior to us and must be received as a gift. At the same time, we are called to protect our humanity, and this means, in the first place, accepting it and respecting it as it was created. – Pope Francis Amoris Laetitia no.56
